

Al Hassan Engineering achieves safety milestone for A'Seeb STP project



MUSCAT — Al Hassan Engineering Co SAOG (AHEC) has garnered two million man-hours without Lost Time Injury on its A'Seeb Sewage Treatment Project for Haya Water/Hyundai Rotem.

The milestone adds to a succession of similar achievements notched up by AHEC on the Health, Safety and Environment (HSE) front.

The company has executed a number of projects in Oil and Gas, Petrochemicals, and Power and Water sectors without any lost time incidents (LTIs), logging 32 million LTI free man-hours since 2007. In 2009, AHEC worked 12.3 million man-hours and drove 14.6 million km without any LTI, repeating this achievement for the second year in

succession.

Commenting on the latest achievement, Peter Hall, CEO-AHEC said: "At AHEC, our workforce is our greatest asset and we invest time in training, and money in safety, to care for our team. Safety awareness is a top priority and measures are in place to ensure our team is looked after. He also thanked Hyundai Rotem and Haya Water for their continued guidance and support on the HSE aspects of the project.

He stressed that the implementation of programmes such as the Safety Training Observation Programme (STOP), Permit to Work Systems, Job Safety Analysis (JSA) and tool box meetings were integral to the success of the sites' zero LTI performances.
